Zech 11:12 I told them, "If you think it best, give me my pay; but if not, keep it." So they paid me <u>thirty pieces of silver</u> .	Matt 26:14-16 14 Then one of the Twelve-the one called Judas Iscariot-went to the chief priests 15 and asked, "What are you willing to give me if I hand him over to you?" So they counted out for him <u>thirty silver coins</u> .
Ps 41:9 Even my close friend, whom I trusted, <u>he who shared my bread</u> , has <u>lifted up his heel against me</u> .	John 13:27 As soon as <u>Judas took the bread</u> , Satan entered into him. "What you are about to do, do quickly," Jesus told him, Mark 14:10 Then Judas Iscariot, one of the Twelve, went to the chief priests to <u>betray Jesus to them</u> .
Ps 38:11 My friends and companions avoid me because of my wounds; my neighbors <u>stay far away</u> . Zech 13:7 "Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, against the man who is close to me!" declares the LORD Almighty. "Strike the shepherd, and <u>the sheep will be scattered</u> , and I will turn my hand against the little ones.	Luke 23:49 But all those who knew him, including the women who had followed him from Galilee, <u>stood at a distance</u> ... Mark 14:50 Then <u>everyone deserted him and fled</u> . Matt 26:31 Then Jesus told them, " <u>This very night you will all fall away on account of me</u> , for it is written: "I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered."
Ps 35:11 <u>Ruthless witnesses come forward</u> ; they question me on things I know nothing about.	Mark 14:56 <u>Many testified falsely against him</u> , but their statements did not agree.
Isa 53:7 He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led <u>like a lamb</u> to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so <u>he did not open his mouth</u> .	Matt 27:12-14 12 When he was accused by the chief priests and the elders, <u>he gave no answer</u> . 13 Then Pilate asked him, "Don't you hear the testimony they are bringing against you?" 14 But <u>Jesus made no reply</u> ... John 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, <u>the Lamb of God</u> , who takes away the sin of the world!"
Ps 69:19-20 19 You know how I am <u>scorned, disgraced and shamed</u> ; all my enemies are before you. 20 Scorn has broken my heart and has left me helpless; I looked for sympathy, but there was none, for comforters, but I found none.	Matt 27:28-29 28 <u>They stripped him</u> and put a scarlet robe on him, 29 and then twisted together a crown of thorns and set it on his head. They put a staff in his right hand and knelt in front of him and <u>mocked him</u> . "Hail, king of the Jews!" they said.
Isa 50:6 I offered my back to those <u>who beat me</u> , my cheeks to those who pulled out my beard; I did not hide my face from <u>mocking</u> and <u>spitting</u> .	Matt 27:30-31 30 <u>They spit on him</u> , and took the staff and <u>struck him</u> on the head again and again. 31 After they had <u>mocked him</u> , they took off the robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they led him away to crucify him.
Zech 12:10-11 10 "And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and supplication. They will look on me, <u>the one they have pierced</u> , and <u>they will mourn for him</u> as one mourns for an only child, and grieve bitterly for him as one grieves for a firstborn son.	Luke 23:27 A large number of people followed him, including women who <u>mourned and wailed</u> for him.
Zech 11:13 And the LORD said to me, " <u>Throw it to the potter</u> "-the <u>handsome price at which they priced me!</u> So I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw them into the house of the LORD to the potter.	Matt 27:3-8 3 When Judas, who had betrayed him, saw that Jesus was condemned, <u>he was seized with remorse and returned the thirty silver coins</u> to the chief priests and the elders. 4 "I have sinned," he said, "for I have betrayed innocent blood." "What is that to us?" they replied. "That's your responsibility." 5 So Judas threw the money into the temple and left. Then he went away and hanged himself. 6 The chief priests picked up the coins and said, "It is against the law to put this into the treasury, since it is blood money." 7 So <u>they decided to use the money to buy the potter's field</u> ...
Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and <u>you will strike his heel</u> ." Ps 22:16 Dogs have surrounded me; a band of evil men has encircled me, they have <u>pierced my hands and my feet</u> .	John 19:18 Here <u>they crucified him</u> , and with him two others-one on each side and Jesus in the middle.

<p>Isa 53:4-6 4 Surely <u>he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows</u>, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. 5 But <u>he was pierced for our transgressions</u>, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and <u>by his wounds we are healed</u>. 6 <u>We all, like sheep, have gone astray</u>, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.</p>	<p>Mark 15:25 It was the third hour when <u>they crucified him</u>. 1 Peter 2:24-25 24 <u>He himself bore our sins</u> in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; <u>by his wounds you have been healed</u>. 25 For <u>you were like sheep going astray</u>, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.</p>
<p>Isa 53:12 Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will <u>divide the spoils</u> with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death, and was <u>numbered with the transgressors</u>. For he bore the sin of many, and <u>made intercession</u> for the transgressors. Ps 22:18 They <u>divide my garments among them</u> and <u>cast lots for my clothing</u>.</p>	<p>Mark 15:27 They <u>crucified two robbers with him</u>, one on his right and one on his left. Luke 23:34 Jesus said, "<u>Father, forgive them</u>, for they do not know what they are doing." And <u>they divided up his clothes</u> by casting lots.</p>
<p>Ps 22:15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd, and <u>my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth</u>; you lay me in the dust of death. Ps 69:21 They put gall in my food and gave me <u>vinegar for my thirst</u>.</p>	<p>John 19:28-30 28 Later, knowing that all was now completed, and so that the Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "<u>I am thirsty</u>." 29 A jar of <u>wine vinegar</u> was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips.</p>
<p>Ps 22:6-8 6 But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by men and despised by the people. 7 All who see me <u>mock me</u>; they <u>hurl insults, shaking their heads</u>: 8 "<u>He trusts in the LORD; let the LORD rescue him</u>. Let him deliver him, since he delights in him." Ps 109:25 I am an object of scorn to my accusers; when they see me, <u>they shake their heads</u>.</p>	<p>Matt 27:39-43 39 Those who passed by <u>hurled insults</u> at him, <u>shaking their heads</u> 40 and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!" 41 In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders <u>mocked him</u>. 42 "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself! He's the King of Israel! Let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. 43 <u>He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now</u> if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God.'"</p>
<p>Isa 53:3 He was <u>despised and rejected</u> by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we <u>esteemed him not</u>.</p>	<p>Mark 15:31-32 31 In the same way the chief priests and the teachers of the law <u>mocked him</u> among themselves. "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself! 32 Let this Christ, this King of Israel, come down now from the cross, that we may see and believe." Those crucified with him also heaped insults on him.</p>
<p>Ps 22:2 O my God, I cry out by day, but you do not answer, by <u>night</u>, and am not silent.</p>	<p>Matt 27:45 From the sixth hour until the ninth hour <u>darkness came over all the land</u>.</p>
<p>Ps 22:1 <u>My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?</u> Why are you so far from saving me, so far from the words of my groaning?</p>	<p>Matt 27:46 About the ninth hour Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "<u>Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?</u>"-which means, "<u>My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?</u>"</p>
<p>Ps 69:3 I am worn out calling for help; my throat is parched. <u>My eyes fail, looking for my God</u>.</p>	<p>Matt 27:45-46 46 About the ninth hour Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?"-which means, "<u>My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?</u>"</p>
<p>Ps 31:5 <u>Into your hands I commit my spirit</u>; redeem me, O LORD, the God of truth.</p>	<p>Luke 23:46 Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, <u>into your hands I commit my spirit</u>." When he had said this, he breathed his last.</p>
<p>Ex 12:46 "It must be eaten inside one house; take none of the meat outside the house. <u>Do not break any of the bones</u>. Ps 34:20 he protects all his bones, <u>not one of them will be broken</u>. Ps 22:17 <u>I can count all my bones</u>; people stare and gloat over me.</p>	<p>John 19:32-33 32 The soldiers therefore came and broke the legs of the first man who had been crucified with Jesus, and then those of the other. 33 But when they came to Jesus and found that he was already dead, <u>they did not break his legs</u>.</p>
<p>Ps 22:14 I am <u>poured out like water</u>, and all my bones are out of joint. My heart has turned to wax; it has melted away within me.</p>	<p>John 19:34 Instead, one of the soldiers pierced Jesus' side with a spear, bringing <u>a sudden flow of blood and water</u>.</p>
<p>Isa 53:9 He was assigned <u>a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death</u>, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth.</p>	<p>Matt 27:57-61 57 As evening approached, there came <u>a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph</u>, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus. 58 Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus' body, and Pilate ordered that it be given to him. 59 <u>Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth</u>, 60 and placed it in his own new tomb...</p>
