<p>Gen 15:1-4 After this, <u>the word of the LORD came to Abram</u> in a vision: "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your very great reward." But Abram said, "O Sovereign LORD, what can you give me since I remain childless and the one who will inherit my estate is Eliezer of Damascus?" And Abram said, "You have given me no children; so a servant in my household will be my heir." Then <u>the word of the LORD came to him</u>: "This man will not be your heir, but <u>a son coming from your own body will be your heir.</u>"</p>	<p>John 1:1 & 14 <u>In the beginning was the Word</u>, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.... The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.</p> <p>Luke 1:30-32 But the angel said to her, "<u>Do not be afraid</u>, Mary, you have found favor with God. You will be with child and <u>give birth to a son</u>, and you are to give him the name Jesus. He will be great..."</p>
<p>Gen 17:17 Abraham fell facedown; he laughed and said to himself, "Will a son be born to a man a hundred years old? <u>Will Sarah bear a child at the age of ninety?</u>"</p>	<p>Luke 1:34-35 "<u>How will this be.</u>" Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?" The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.</p>
<p>Gen 22:2 ...God said, "<u>Take your son, your only son</u>, Isaac, whom you love, and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there..."</p>	<p>John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave <u>His only begotten son</u>...</p>
<p>Gen 22:3 Early the next morning Abraham got up and <u>saddled his donkey</u>. He took with him <u>two of his servants</u> and his son Isaac. When he had cut enough wood for the burnt offering, he set out for the place God had told him about.</p>	<p>John 12:14-15 Jesus <u>found a young donkey and sat upon it</u>, as it is written, "Do not be afraid, O Daughter of Zion; see, your king is coming, seated on a donkey's colt."</p> <p>Matt 27:38 <u>Two robbers were crucified with him</u>, one on his right and one on his left.</p>
<p>Gen 22:2 Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, Isaac, whom you love, and go to the region of Moriah. <u>Sacrifice him there</u> as a burnt offering on one of the mountains I will tell you about."</p> <p>2 Chr 3:1 Then Solomon began to build the temple of the LORD in Jerusalem on Mount Moriah...</p>	<p>Matt 20:18 "<u>We are going up to Jerusalem</u>, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and the teachers of the law. <u>They will condemn him to death</u></p>
<p>Gen 22:4 <u>On the third day</u> Abraham looked up and saw the place in the distance. He said to his servants, "Stay here with the donkey while I and the boy go over there. We will worship and then <u>we will come back to you.</u>"</p>	<p>Matt 17:22-23 When they came together in Galilee, he said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of men. They will kill him, and <u>on the third day he will be raised to life.</u>" And the disciples were filled with grief.</p>
<p>Gen 22:6-7 Abraham took the wood for the burnt offering and placed it on his son Isaac, and he himself carried the fire and the knife. As the two of them went on together, Isaac spoke up and said to his father Abraham, "Father?" "Yes, my son?" Abraham replied. "The fire and wood are here," Isaac said, "but <u>where is the lamb for the burnt offering?</u>"</p>	<p>John 19:17 <u>Carrying his own cross</u>, he went out to the place of the Skull (which in Aramaic is called Golgotha).</p> <p>John 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, <u>the Lamb of God</u>, who takes away the sin of the world!</p>
<p>Gen 22: 11-13 But <u>the angel of the LORD</u> called out to him from heaven, "Abraham! Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. "Do not lay a hand on the boy," he said. "Do not do anything to him. Now I know that you fear God, because you have not withheld from me your son, your only son." <u>Abraham looked up and there in a thicket he saw a ram caught by its horns. He went over and took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering instead of his son.</u></p>	<p>Eph 5:2 ...<u>Christ loved us and gave himself up for us</u> as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.</p>
<p>Gen 22:18 "...through your offspring <u>all nations on earth will be blessed</u>, because you have obeyed me."</p>	<p>Matt 12:18 "Here is my servant whom I have chosen, the one I love, in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and <u>he will proclaim justice to the nations.</u>"</p>
